- How does the high verification rate for Hawai'i Energy compare with verification rates in other jurisdictions?
- ODC responded that within 2-3 years of experience running a portfolio, near 100% verification is pretty typical.
- The EEM noted, however, that while verification based on nominal savings based on TRMs is very high, often there are material verification differences in jurisdictions that assess "ex post" savings as measured against actual performance.

### **Hawai'i Energy Perspectives / Insights on PY2018 Planning**

- This is an exciting time with lots of evolution going on in programs.
- Accelerating changes to the lighting elements of the program earlier than previously planned
- Residential program cost-effectiveness is expected to go down but emphasis on transformational programs is going up.
- Restarting auditing because the pipeline of future projects (2-3 year maturation cycle) needs to be refilled.

- Overdriving of commercial programs is causing a shift toward a higher actual commercial/residential split. This will need to be addressed going forward in PBF collections.
- A new potential study is a very important thing for designing future programs and Hawaii Energy hopes the timing of the potential study meshes well with the planning for the next big planning cycle (PY2019)
- Interested in the Kavala Open Pathways project which will inform locational value of efficiency.
- Plan to complete draft PY2018 Annual Plan by mid-late April to give stakeholders more time to review and comment on the document.
