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Context

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Hawai'i Perspective – balancing cost, time, value

- Appropriate approaches have been used given the scale, scope and nature of PBFA programs
- However some revisiting is in order with regards to the savings values assigned to measures because:
 - Longer than intended time since last major updates to key documents
 - Programs and markets have and are changing
 - Measures will likely become more complex and probably more expensive

- Increased recognition of value of market transformation
- The RPS has moved to 100% and EE's (and all DERs') roles are affected, perhaps with new primary metrics
- Increased recognition of low-income and HTR markets

PY17 Hawai'i Energy Portfolio Verification

PY17 verification has started

- Tetra Tech is the lead for EM&V Contractor Team
- To be completed by end of December
- Focus verification of energy (kWh), demand (kW), and total resource benefits (TRBs) stemming from Hawaii Energy's PY2017 activities.
- Additionally, the verification of market transformation (MT), customer/island equity, and customer satisfaction goals are included in the verification plan.

Scope

- Verify that project documentation matches program records
- Verify that TRM values/methods are properly applied
- Verify, via a sample, custom energy and demand savings calculations using engineering reviews and about 30 site visits
- Verify MT, customer/island equity, and customer satisfaction results

Other PBFA EM&V Activities

Peer Program

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- Hawai'i Energy has selected a new implementer for Peer, the home energy reports program
- Peer is using new deemed savings values for PY18
- A control group has also been selected for analyses, for at least PY18 (about 10% of prior participants were randomly selected to stop receiving reports)

Other Topics of Interest

- System Loss Factor
- Net to gross, baseline and measure lifetimes, particularly for LEDs
- Avoided costs and discount factors for cost-effectiveness analyses
- TRM and TRM Framework
